The U Care shelter is an old building and as with many old buildings there is a need for repairs. This year we have experienced major leaks, plumbing, heating, and roofing issues. There are few funds available for structural repairs, however, a letter to community supporters explaining our situation was favorably received and resulted in contributions of more than \$ 10,000! All of the responses are appreciated as U Care could not function without generous donations and the efforts the community provides. The monies received aided in repairs, yet there are numerous projects left unfinished.

The Domestic Violence vigil is held each year to remember those who have lost their lives to domestic violence and honor the survivors. Sheriff Jimmy Thornton shared with the audience startling statistics on “acts of domestic violence” in North Carolina. As of October 2009, fifty-seven domestic violence deaths have occurred in the state of North Carolina according to the Sheriff. Mrs. Joyce Owens, the manager of Matthews Cards and Gifts, spoke in memory of her co-

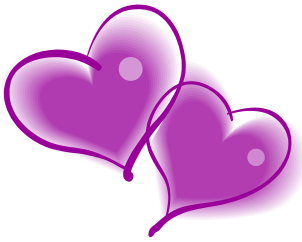

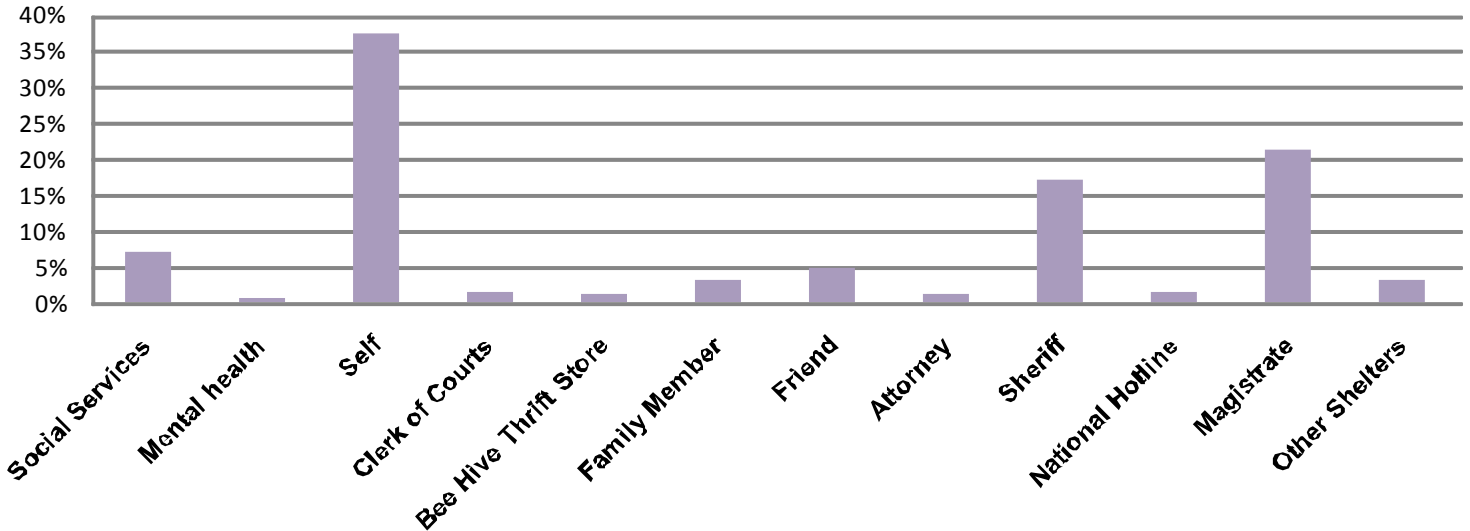

## What do we mean when we talk about DATING ABUSE?

Dating abuse isn't an argument every once in a while, or a bad mood after a bad day. Dating abuse (or Relationship Abuse) is a **pattern of controlling behavior** that someone uses against a girlfriend or boyfriend.

Abuse can cause injury and even death, but it **doesn't have to be physical**. It can include verbal and emotional abuse – constant insults, isolation from family and friends, name calling, controlling what someone wears-and it can also include sexual abuse.

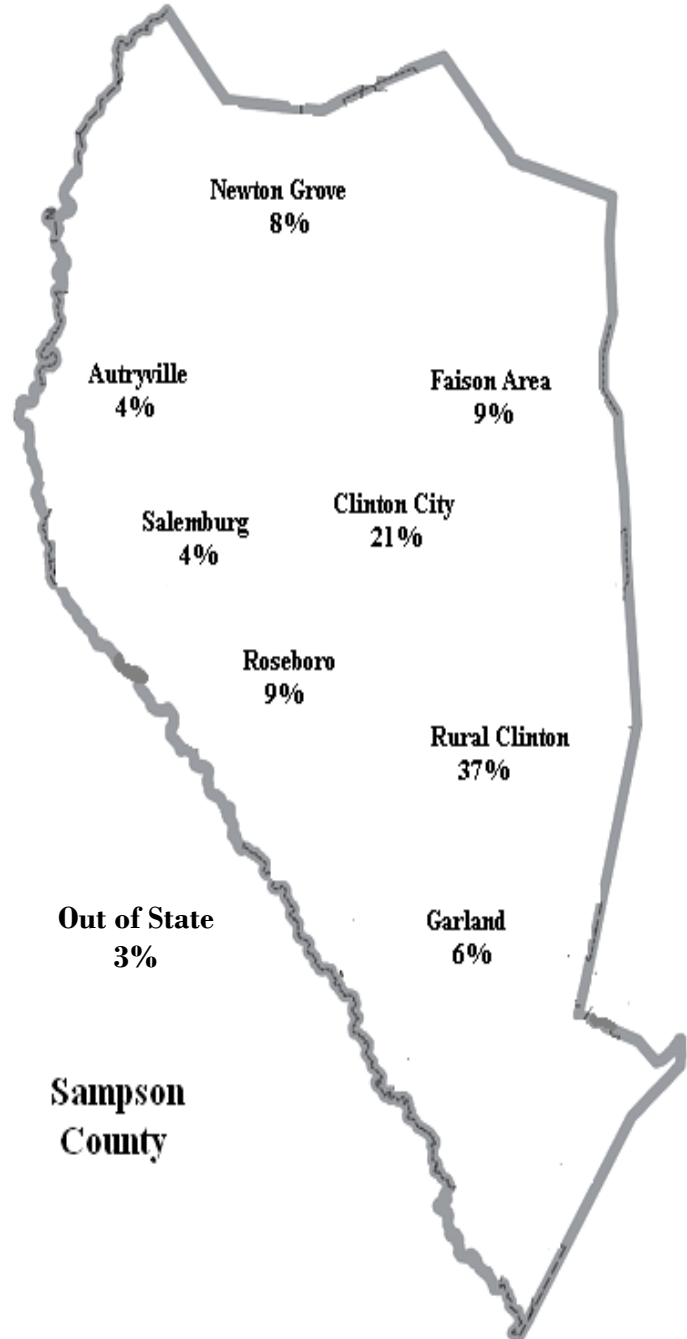

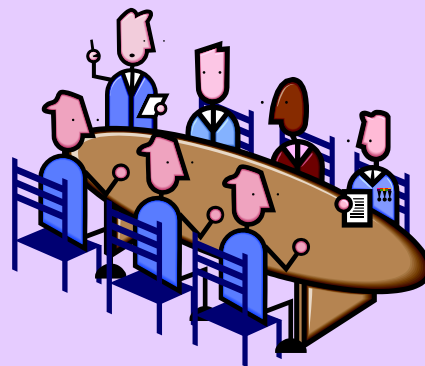
